This privacy notice is provided by Theridion Limited of Cullen House, Broad Street, Montgomery SY15 6PH.

What information do we collect?

We collect your personal data when it is necessary for carrying out contracted services for you. We do not collect any sensitive personal data about you, your staff, customers or visitors. Through the nature of the services we provide to you, we may collect and process information about you, your staff, customers or visitors such as images taken from CCTV systems.

Theridion provides business-to-business services including remote video (CCTV) which is used for maintaining the security of property and premises and for preventing and investigating crime. It may also be used to monitor staff when carrying out work duties. For these reasons, the information processed may include video images.

How do we use your personal data?

We may use your personal data to:

- carry on our business and promote our products and services
- carry out our obligations arising from service contracts
- administer our website and other marketing and communications channels
- comply with our statutory and regulatory obligations

We will not share your personal data with others unless we are under a legal duty to do so, or we use third parties to carry out business activities or you have agreed to it being shared with third parties for relevant marketing activity.

How secure is your data?

We store your personal details on a secure server within the EEA. Where you have a password that enables you to access certain services, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal information from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed. We only keep your personal data for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for.
